# SILVERHILL PRIMARY SCHOOL'S GROUNDS FOR CHANGE PROJECT

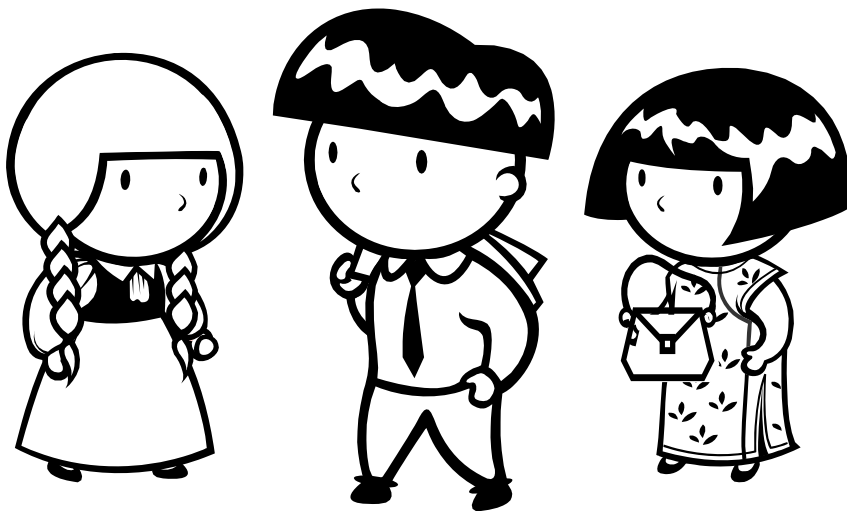
*The creation of a new and exciting learning environment, with particular focus on the outside area.*
