### REMINDER - ILLNESS

It is essential that if children have been sick with vomiting and/or diarrhoea they are kept at home for 48 hours after the last bout of illness. Illnesses are spreading rapidly through the school community because pupils are returning to school before they are clear from infection. Please help us to keep our school healthy by adhering to this directive from the Local Authority.

In addition if your child is due to go swimming on a Monday they will be excluded from swimming for two weeks if they have been suffering from diarrhoea.

### CHRISTMAS CARDS

A number of parents have approached me to ask if there is some way we can reduce the amount of Christmas cards that the children send to each other at school.

It has been suggested by parents that the children either send a card to their class, or to one or two friends. The money that would have been spent on cards can then be attached to a cardboard bauble which the children will be given in school.
