To finish our topic 'Where is Sunny?' we will be holding an animal habitat day on Tuesday 27th November. We would love it if an adult (mum, dad, gran, grandad, auntie etc) could join us at 2pm until 3.30pm for an afternoon of Design Technology with your child! Your child will design a shoebox habitat on Wed 14th November and we will send a copy home for you to look at. You can then collect all the bits and bobs you need (toilet rolls/ toothpaste boxes/ miniature toys etc) inside a NAMED shoebox and send it into school on Monday 26th November ready for the making challenge on Tuesday afternoon. We are hoping the children can explore some of the cutting and joining skills they learnt in Year 1 and use them to good effect! We will be providing junk modelling essentials such as coloured card, tissue paper, glue, selotape, paint, felt tips etc.

We are also asking the children to come to school on Tuesday 27th November dressed as an animal from their shoebox habitat. Again, the emphasis is on designing and making rather than spending money on a bought costume so please don't feel the need to order expensive costumes.

We hope you can join us for this special event. If an adult is unable to come in and support your child with this activity please let your child's class teacher know via Dojo messages and we will ensure they are paired up with somebody else. We understand that a 2pm slot is unmanageable for some parents.
